- Introduction of instructor f and the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission
- Introduce the concept of wildlife jeopardy
 - Have teacher divide students into 2 different teams
 - o Explain rules and how each team will take turns picking categories
 - How scoring works
 - How "stealing" questions and points work
- Play jeopardy until about 5 minutes left then finish scoring
- Have students ask questions if they have any
- Talk about how teachers can use Wild What's Up if they have more questions during the year
