Making of a Habitat Rules

- 1) No mixing colors. You can only have one color (prairie, woods, or campground) in each box.
- 2) There can only be one of the same species in each box (Cannot put 2 deer or 2 pheasant in the same box).
- 3) Deer, pheasants, quail and pollinators mix in the wild. You can put these different types of animals in a box. (For example, a deer and a pheasant).
- 4) Hunters need plenty of space to remain safe while hunting. Hunters must be spaced 3 blocks apart.
- 5) Because it is dangerous going out during hunting season without a blaze orange jacket, hunters and bird watchers cannot be in the same box.
